National Trophy Rifle Matches at Camp Perry Ohio

Each year the Texas State Rifle Association (TSRA) is represented at Camp Perry, Ohio for the CMP National Trophy Rifle Matches.

For the past three years, the TSRA Adult Gold Team has dominated the Civilian competition, including this year where their score in the Trophy Team Match was a new national record. This year was no different with repeat wins in the National Trophy Team Match earning them the Soldier of Marathon trophy for the third year in a row. They were the top civilian team (third overall) in the National Trophy Infantry Team Match, earning them the Leatherneck Trophy for the second year in a row. Adult Gold Team consisted of Coach Dave Wilson, Captain Tony Miller, Lee Eldridge, Samantha Holt, Kyle Hoelscher, Buddy Reich, Keith Stephens and Jason Utley. For the Leatherneck Trophy match, Jason Utley captained and Tony Miller was a shooter.

Along with outstanding team shooting, TSRA Service Rifle Team was blessed with several outstanding individual shooters. Foremost among them was Keith Stephens of College Station. Keith won the prestigious President's Rifle Trophy with a score of 393X17. Buddy Reich was third in the President's Rifle Trophy match with a score of 393X14. Buddy's score in P100 was a new national record for a senior. Additional individual adult awards were earned by Buddy Reich of Gates, winning High Senior and Jeff Illiff of Dallas, winning High Law Enforcement Rifle award.

Keith Stephens also won the Pietroforte Trophy, awarded to the High Civilian for the aggregate of the National Trophy Individual and National Trophy Team scores. PLUS,
